**WELFARE FOOD SCHEME**

**Summary**

1. This letter notifies a change in the price to be paid by Family Credit recipients for dried baby milk and a change in the name of one of the manufacturing companies.

**Action**

2. The attention of staff at maternity and child health clinics, welfare distribution centres and supplies staff should be drawn to the following changes:

2.1 the price to be paid by Family Credit recipients of dried baby milk will increase - as a result of the annual uprating of Social Security benefits - from £3.10 to £3.30 per 900 grammes.

2.2 John Wyeth and Brother Limited - manufacturers of SMA Gold and SMA White - have changed their company names to SMA Nutrition. The product names are unaltered.
