AT HOME IN HOSPITAL: A GUIDE
CHILDREN FIRST: A STUDY OF HOSPITAL SERVICES

Summary

1 This letter brings to your attention two guidance documents: "At Home in Hospital - a Guide to Care of Children and Young People" prepared by the Health Policy and Public Directorate and the Audit Commission Report: "Children First: A Study of Hospital Services".

2 "At home in hospital" is based on the Department of Health document: "Welfare of Children and Young People in Hospital" which was issued to health boards in Scotland in January 1992 for information. The Guide has been specifically tailored to meet Scottish needs and circumstances.

Action

3 General Managers and Chief Executives are asked to take into account the principles and recommendations set out in the Guide:

- ◆ when developing service specifications for children's hospital services
- ◆ agency contacts
- ◆ ensuring delivery of high quality, efficient services.

4 You are also asked to consider the findings of the Audit Commission's report which, although it is based on shortcomings identified in England and Wales, contains principles of care equally applicable to Scotland. The Scottish Office Audit Unit will be reporting early in 1994 on their audit of hospital services for children in Scotland.
