POLICY ON DISPOSAL OF CLINICAL WASTE: SAFE HANDLING AND DISPOSAL

## Summary

1. The purpose of this letter is to bring to your attention the recent publication of a guidance document entitled "Safe Disposal of Clinical Waste" prepared by the Health Services Advisory Committee and published by the Health and Safety Executive following endorsement by the Health and Safety Commission.

## Action

- 2. The guidance document is an authoritative document which is used by Health and Safety Inspectors in describing reliable and fully acceptable methods of achieving health and safety in the workplace. Whilst the guidance document has no legal force, its standing as agreed practical guidance means that it may be referred to in court to demonstrate the standards that need to be met under the Law.
- 3. Within the guidance document there is advice on appointing Clinical Waste Control Officers. These Officers would be accountable to the Chief Executive or General Manager and be managed on a day-to-day basis by the appropriate Director or Head of Service.
- 4. More specifically, I would bring to your attention paragraphs 124-127 (page 17) of the document which describe the "Disposal of Pharmaceutical Waste" and remind you that the details of such related procedures in Scotland are outlined in NHS Circular MEL(1992)6 dated 5 November 1992.
- 5. I enclose a copy of the Guidance Note and ask you to note that further copies priced £4.50 are available from the HMSO Publications Centre, PO Box 276, London SW8 5DT and from all HMSO bookshops and accredited agents under publication reference, ISBN 0 11 886355X.
