HOSPITAL COMPLAINTS PROCEDURE ACT 1985

Summary

1. This Circular applies the terms of the Hospital Complaints Procedure Act 1985 Direction 1991 to those NHS Trusts which come into operation on 1 April 1994. It also requires Trusts to provide statistical information on the handling of complaints from that date.

Action

- 2. The Direction attached at Annex A requires the NHS Trusts listed in the Schedule to comply with the terms of the 1991 Direction issued to Health Boards on 19 September 1991. For convenience the 1991 Direction is attached as Annex B.
- 3. Most NHS Trusts will already be complying with some of the requirements of the 1991 Direction in their present role as Directly Managed Units. However, some additional requirements of the Direction will now have to be met in relation to the monitoring of complaints (paragraph 4) and publicity for the complaints procedure (paragraph 5).
- 4. Under the terms of the Act the Direction applies only to the complaints of hospital patients but the Secretary of State would like Trusts to adopt similar procedures in respect of community health services.
- 5. The Direction includes no universal maximum timescale for dealing with complaints. Trusts should set their own standards against which performance should be assessed.
- 6. NHS Circular GEN(1992)27 introduced a system to collect statistical data on complaints from Health Boards and Trusts. The Trusts referred to in the 1994 Direction attached are required to submit returns direct to Information and Statistics Division beginning with the April-June 1994 quarter. Chief Executives are asked to nominate an officer who will
