WELFARE FOOD SCHEME

Summary

1. This letter informs Health Boards and NHS Trusts of a change in the price to be paid by Family Credit recipients for dried baby-milk and a change in brand name of dried baby-milk listed for supply under the Welfare Food Scheme.

Action

2. The following changes should be brought to the attention of all staff in maternity and child health clinics, approved retail pharmacies and supplies staff.

2.1 From 19 August 1994 the price to be paid by Family Credit recipients for 900 grammes of dried baby-milk will increase from £3.40 to £3.50.

2.2 Farley's Ostermilk and Ostermilk Two have been renamed Farley's First Milk and Farley's Second Milk respectively.
