HEALTH PROMOTION AND SCREENING IN OPHTHALMOLOGY

Summary

This letter draws the attention of Health Boards, Trusts and directly managed units to the attached report, prepared by the Study Group on the Management of Ophthalmology Services in Scotland. The Study Group was appointed in September 1990, under the chairmanship of Professor L G Whitby, and has latterly been chaired by Dr J H Spenceley.

Background

This report, the sixth to have been prepared by the Study Group, identifies a number of areas within ophthalmology where patients/consumers can help to improve their quality of life, and examines the cost implications of a range of interventions.
