THE NHS (GENERAL MEDICAL AND PHARMACEUTICAL SERVICES) (SCOTLAND) AMENDMENT (NO.2) REGULATIONS 1994

Summary

- 1. This letter advises Health Boards of deletions from and additions to the list of drugs in Schedule 2A to the NHS (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) (Scotland) Regulations 1974 which lists the drugs and other substances not to be supplied by general medical practitioners or prescribed for supply under pharmaceutical services. It also advises Health Boards of one deletion and 2 additions to Schedule 2B of the aforementioned Regulations.
- 2. The changes are set out in the NHS (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) (Scotland) Amendment (No.2) Regulations 1994. The provisions come into force on 1 November 1994. Details are given overleaf. A small supply of the SI will be sent to Health Boards under separate cover.

Action

- 3. Health Boards are asked to distribute <u>as</u> <u>quickly as possible</u> to all general medical practitioners and chemist contractors a copy of the Memorandum to this letter. Bulk supplies of the Memorandum are being sent under separate cover.
- 4. Health Boards should send copies of the Memorandum to the Area Medical Committee, GP Sub-Committee and the Area Pharmaceutical Committee.
- 5. This letter should be copied to Unit General Managers for information.

THE NHS (GENERAL MEDICAL AND PHARMACEUTICAL SERVICES) (SCOTLAND) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1994

- 1. This Memorandum advises general medical practitioners and chemist contractors of deletions from and additions to the list of drugs in Schedule 2A to the NHS (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) (Scotland) Regulations 1974 which lists the drugs and other substances not to be supplied by general medical practitioners or prescribed for supply under pharmaceutical services. It also advises of one deletion and 2 additions to Schedule 2B of the aforementioned Regulations.
- 2. The changes are set out in detail in the NHS (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) (Scotland) Amendment (No.2) Regulations 1994. The provisions come into operation on 1 November 1994 (see details below).
