AGENDA FOR CHANGE: PAYMENT OF ON-CALL ALLOWANCES AND CALL OUTS DURING PERIODS OF SICK LEAVE

Summary

1. PAYMENT OF ON-CALL ALLOWANCES AND CALL OUTS DURING PERIODS OF SICK LEAVE

The Scottish Terms and Conditions Committee (STAC) recently discussed the issue of pay during sick leave in relation to compliance with the Agenda for Change Terms and Conditions of Service Handbook. Paragraph 14.4 of the Handbook reads as follows:

"The definition of full pay will include regularly paid supplements, including any recruitment and retention premia, payments for work outside normal hours and high cost area supplements. Sick pay is calculated on the basis of what the individual would have received had he/she been at work. This would be based on the previous three months at work or any other reference period that may be locally agreed. Local partnerships can use virtual rotas showing what hours the employee would have worked in a reference period had he or she been at work".

It is noted that there are different interpretations of this across Boards in relation to the payment of on-call allowance and call outs when on sick leave. Following discussion with NHS Staff Council colleagues, Scottish advice is that on-call allowance and payment for call outs (i.e. payments both for availability and for work done) should be included in pay during sick leave regardless of whether staff are on the Agenda for Change on-call arrangement or a protected on-call arrangement. Boards should therefore include these payments in sick pay effective from 1 October 2010. Retrospective application of this advice dates from no earlier than 1 October 2004 and is a matter for Boards to consider locally and resolve through their partnership mechanisms.
