

OFT Report on Deregulation of Community Pharmacies

Dear Ms Brankin,

There are a number of important issues that require to be addressed regarding the report by the Office of Fair Trading (OFT) which recommends that the pharmacy licencing system be totally derregulated.

1. The recommendation by OFT to deregulate appears to have been made through a consideration of only one aspect of the service provided by Community Pharmacists, viz. the retail aspect of price competition in relation to over the counter medicines. In our Pharmacy this accounts for a small proportion of our work (10%).


2. With the emphasis of the OFT on trading and prices little if any cognisance and/or recognition of the professional nature of the role of the Community Pharmacists is apparent. He/she appears to be considered only as a shopkeeper. Proper appreciation of the Pharmacist's professional role and the implications of deregulation on this and on health care provision in the community requires to be addressed by an authority competent to do so. The competence and impartiality of the OFT in this regard has to be questioned. Some aspects of the professional role of the pharmacist referred to above include the maintenance of patients' medication records, patient review and optimisation of drug therapy, prevention of adverse effects and public health initiatives such as supervision of administration of methadone and needle exchange for drug addicts.

3. The regulations of the control of entry have provided a considered distribution of pharmacies (by competent health care professionals) and an efficient provision of Community Pharmacy Services which meets the needs of patients and a modern NHS. Their abolition would mean a free for all with services provided primarily on the basis of commercial profit with health care a secondary consideration. This has implications particularly for patients where access to a pharmacy is difficult or impossible or where current services would no longer be available. The latter include extemporaneous dispensing of specials, delivery of medicines, provision of monitored dosage systems of medicines, supply of oxygen and call out after duty hours to dispense medicines in emergencies. These are at present provided routinely by our pharmacy.

4. Uncontrolled distribution of pharmacies would have a destabiling effect on Community pharmacy services in general with loss of confidence by pharmacists and patients alike. It inevitably would lead to closure of some existing privately owned pharmacies on economic grounds with loss of comprehensive services currently provided to the patient, particularly if the competition was from an organisation motivated primarily by profit and unwilling to provide the level of service expected.

I should be grateful if you would kindly bring these comments to the attention of the Scottish Health Ministers with a view to informing the Scottish Executive about the adverse effects of the OFT's recommendations on pharmacy and the health care of patients in the Community.
